

mHealth Advisory Group: Scope

Advisory to the IT Steering Committee, the Mobile Health (mHealth) Advisory Group addresses the growing business demand for mobile health solutions at UCLA.

Scope:

The scope of governance for this group is limited to mobile device and applications use within healthcare, medical education and patient related research at UCLA. We provide guidance and strategic support for operationalizing mHealth use by:

- UCLA providers, staff, and medical students
- Patients receiving care by UCLA's hospitals and clinics
- UCLA patients participating in research projects

Scope Exclusions

The UCLA mHealth Advisory Group currently does NOT provide the following services:

- Centralized coordination of UCLA's mobile health research efforts
- Direction for non-patient, non-clinician use of mobile technology on UCLA's academic campus

mHealth Advisory Group Charter

The mobile health (mHealth) advisory group provides leadership, standards & strategic planning for UCLA health data mobility projects and innovations including the following key functions:

- Establishes a formal venue to assess, support & scale adoption of new mobile health technologies.
- Provides consensus & decisions on mobility access solutions & standards and ensures appropriate design and capacity review
- Assesses and approves decisions regarding mHealth integration with existing ISS systems
- Tracks & reviews known mHealth projects to identify risks, critical path issues & action plans
- Formation and development of mHealth strategic goals, roadmap and portfolio of solutions* in alignment with organizational priorities.
- In an advisory role to the IT Steering Committee, the group facilitates collaboration with and appropriate escalation to other existing governance boards and consultants including but not limited to: Health Science Compliance Oversight Board, IT prioritization committee, E2, AOAG, IAG, and the compliance/security review team.
- Partners with key mHealth stakeholders to promote awareness of emerging mobile technology innovations – both at UCLA and within the competitive marketplace
- Provides strategic insight to position UCLA Health as a market leader at the forefront of viable mobile health technology use.
